

Terms and Conditions for Private Patients

By attending for consultation or treatment, you agree to my terms and agree to pay any fees and charges due to me for the above.

Charges/ Fees

You can pay for the consultation via your Health Insurance or Self-Pay.

If you have Private Insurance, please obtain an Authorization code from your insurer before the consultation as you will need to provide this on the day of the appointment.

If you choose to self-pay, I require my fees to be settled in full BEFORE the consultation. Fees can be paid by preferably by BACS transfer or cheque (payable to GAUKUJ Limited).

The account details for BACS transfer will be provided by my secretary during the process of setting up the appointment

Please note that, neither I nor the hospital accept payment by Credit Card.

Scale of charges

My current charges for outpatient consultation are available on request.

My fees generally fare in line with the approved scale of consultation charges set out by most major private insurance companies. However, please check with your insurance company for any excesses that you may have on your policy. If there is a difference in the charges, you will be required to pay the difference.

Data protection

Your medical records are kept in paper files and administrative records on a computer. All reasonable efforts are made to keep these secure, and other than medical personnel involved in your child's care or my administrative staff, information will not be passed to any third parties without your consent.

You may obtain a copy of the medical records I hold about your child, but an additional charge may be payable.
